

JSA Web Site Map

When viewing the home page at www.JSALIS.org you will notice that the web site is set up as a library of useful information for your use as a sailor, a parent, an instructor or a club program leader.

Tabbed navigation: along the top of the page are tabs that include:

- *JibeTalk blog* sends you directly to the blog at www.JibeTalk.com
- *Calendar* sends you to the JSA online event calendar at <http://calendar.jsalis.org/>
- *Online waiver database* sends you to the waiver and regatta database at <https://www.jsalis.org/db/login.php>
- *Online navigation course* send you to a page that describes the course used by big boat sailors
- *Info for parents* is a page that contains selected info of interest to parents
- *Info for sailors* is a page that contains selected info of interest to sailors
- *Info for program chairs* is a page that contains selected info of interest to program chairs
- *Info for instructors* is a page that contains selected info of interest to instructors
- *Contact JSA* provides info on the office, staff and board members

Resources along the left side of the page has quick links to topics including:

- *Training, clinics, workshops and resources*: Workshops for Program Leaders, Instructors and Sailor Clinics. Boathandling and tuning; Curriculum resources; Head instructor workshop materials; Tactics
- *Program management resources*: Information and resources of use in managing programs. Contains handouts from JSA meetings, regatta entry forms, user guides for the online database, the worksheet required to advise JSA of member families, and so on.
- *Regatta management resources*: This page has information and resources of use to programs running JSA regattas. It contains NOR and SI templates as well as guides to managing events and using the online database to simplify registration processes.
- *Big boat resources*: Navigation Training Resources; Big Boat Manual; Big Boat Programs and Insurance; Big Boat Program Guidelines from US Sailing and Black Rock YC.
- *Navigation/Seamanship course* send you to a page that describes the course.
- *Newsletters*: from 2006 – 2008 prior to the commencement of the online blog
- *Regatta Documents and Results*: Dates; Title; Location; Notice of Race; Sailing Instructions; Results
- *Important links*: Champs Qualifying Calculations; Regatta Results; Tide and weather information; JSA Laser Sail Numbers
